All the Dist Educational Officers in the state are informed that in the references read above, certain Teachers Associations have requested to change the school hours of Urdu parallel/exclusive schools and Urdu Medium DIETs from 8.00 AM to 1.30 PM from 21.7.2012 to 20-8-2012. during the RAMZAN period.

They are informed that as per the school academic calendar for the year 2012-13 the School Management Committees may slightly modify the school timings and intimate the same to the field functionaries. The timings should not be less than 5 hours for Urdu exclusive and parallel Primary Schools and 5 ½ hours for urdu exclusive and parallel Upper Primary ,High schools & Urdu Medium DIETs.

They are, therefore, requested to issue necessary instructions to the Urdu Medium Primary, Upper Primary & High Schools and DIETS under their control to maintain the School hours form 8.00AM to1.30 PM, during RAMZAN period i.e from 21.7.2012 to 20-8-2012. These instructions are applicable to the Urdu medium schools and parallel sections and urdu medium DIETS in the state.
